Introduction:

Choosing the best school for your child can be challenging with so many options. At Penryn, we understand the financial pressures families face, especially with the current economic situation, and we work hard to offer affordable, quality independent education.

However, maintaining educational standards requires sufficient funding. At Penryn, enrollment includes a contract for fee payment in exchange for education. If fees are not paid, the school reserves the right to cancel the contract and exclude the student.

Please note that tuition fees have increased in 2026 to cover rising operational costs. Penryn is a registered Public Benefit and Non-Profit Organisation. Donations to our Development Fund may be eligible for tax deductions under Section 18A of the Income Tax Act.

Options for the payment of fees:

A discounted rate is offered for annual tuition paid in full upfront. Families who settle the entire 2026 tuition by close of business on December 31, 2025, or January 31, 2026, will be eligible for the reduced rates—please see the tables below for more information. Payments made after January 31, 2026, will be subject to the full tuition amount. We encourage timely payment to take advantage of the discount.

Sibling and loyalty discounts introduced in 2023 are still in effect. Additional information is provided below.

The monthly debit-order system: (see Annexure B).

Debit orders are processed over 10-months, from February to November.

For your convenience, there are four possible debit order dates – the 1st, 7th, 15th or the 25th day of the month.

Termly debit-order system:

These payments go through on the FIRST Friday of each new term. **If payment is not made by debit order, then termly fees are due at the start of each new term. All payments are due in advance.** In the event of debit orders returned due to insufficient funds or any other reason, an administrative fee of **R500** will be levied. Credit cards / Debit cards payments:

These can be made at the Cashier's office.

EFT:

Cash:

For security reasons, **parents are requested not to bring cash to the School cashier**. Cash payments must please be deposited directly at any First National Bank into Penryn's account.

Please use your child's name and surname as the reference when making your payment and e-mail your proof of payment through to debtors@penryn.co.za.

Please note that due to the high banking charges levied on our account, when cash is deposited we will charge a fee to the equivalent of 1% of the cash deposit value to your account.

Account statements:

All debit statements for school fees and extras are emailed to parents on a bi-monthly basis, credit statements are sent once a term. Please ensure that these details are updated regularly.

Cheques:

We unfortunately do not accept any cheques.

Credit card payments:

Credit card payments are accepted. We do not accept Diners Club or American Express.

Returned debit orders:

In the event of debit orders returned due to insufficient funds or any other reason, an administrative fee of **R500** will be levied. Only cash (by direct deposit) or credit card payments will be accepted as further payment on accounts for which debit orders have been returned by the bank.

Interest on arrear accounts:

Interest will be charged on overdue accounts at a rate equivalent to the prime interest rate.

Notice periods:

Parents are reminded that in terms of the agreement signed by them at the time of the child's enrolment, they are required to give a full term's notice in writing (addressed to the Head of that school) if it is their intention to remove their child/children from Penryn. Alternatively, they are required to pay a term's fees in lieu of notice.

Breach of contract:

Outstanding fees are a breach of contract with the school. Penryn reserves the right to terminate a contract that is in breach.

Please note that:

Additional costs may apply throughout the year, depending on grade level and sporting activities. Parents will be notified as these charges arise. Penryn reserves the right to review, amend, and correct any errors, including adjustments to fees and amounts charged to accounts during the year.

*No discount on boarding fees.

*Boarding fees are payable in advance and must be paid by the FIRST Friday of the new term.

*Weekly boarding fees exclude weekends and both weekly and termly boarding fees exclude laundry.

DISCOUNTS:

Early Settlement Discount:

- Pay 2026 tuition fees by 31 December 2025 and receive 6% discount on tuition fees.
- Pay 2026 tuition fees by 31 January 2026 and receive 4% discount on tuition fees.

Sibling Discount:

- 10% on tuition fees for second child.
- 15% on tuition fees for third child.
- 20% on tuition fees for fourth+ child.

Loyalty Discount:

- 10% discount on scholars who have been at Penryn for more than 10 years.

Terms and Conditions to qualify for Discount:

- Only one discount is allowed
- As fees are due in advance, loyalty & sibling discounts will only be allowed if tuition fees are settled at the start of each term. Should the fees not be settled in the first week of the new term the discount will be forfeited.
- Should the full tuition portion be settled by the end of December (6%) or end January (4%), only the early settlement discount will be allowed.
- Loyalty discounts may be allowed to siblings already receiving a sibling discount.
- Discounts may only be allowed when tuition fees are paid in advance, as those opting to make use of the monthly payment option may not be eligible for the discounts, as this is a payment plan.
- All scholars in the family's accounts are to be up to date i.e paid in advance to qualify for the sibling/loyalty discounts
- Dates for term fees to be paid:
 - Term 1 – fees to be paid by 16 January 2026
 - Term 2 – fees to be paid by 17 April 2026
 - Term 3 – fees to be paid by 24 July 2026
 - Term 4 – fees to be paid by 9 October 2026

Annual Levy and Field Trips: (please see breakdown in Annexure A)

The annual levy includes:

- Resource and facilities levy. This is to partially recover the costs of textbooks, photocopies, teaching materials (both manual and electronic) as well as the Facility levy, Wi-Fi levy and Music Lab levy.
- Stationery packs – Up to Grade 5
- Subscriptions – Mathematics, Reading Eggs, etc. (*See Annexure A*)
- Workbooks – Grades R – 7
- Annual Levy and Field trips / outings
- Kingfishers to Grade 2 attend an annual outing and there are compulsory field trips for all scholars from Grades 3 to 7. The costs of these trips, which include the transport, accommodation, food and other expenses are invoiced during the first term and added to the school fee account and where applicable will be included in the monthly/termly debit orders.

The following conditions apply to the entrance fee:

- Please note that this fee is not related to the tuition fees of Penryn and is allocated solely to the capital development or maintenance of Penryn.
- The entrance fees are non-refundable.
- Scholars leaving Pre-School to enter Junior Primary will be required to pay a top-up entrance fee as required. This amount will be billed to the scholar's account in the first term of the new phase.

The following conditions will apply to foreign based parents on application and before entrance into Penryn namely:

- A **non-refundable** entrance fee according to the above fees table must be paid following the successful application of the scholar to enter Penryn.
- In addition, foreign-based parents will be required to pay the following **refundable** deposits, which will be topped up annually to keep up with the increase in fees - payable by 1 January each year, namely:
- Academic - equivalent to 1 (one) terms fees.

- This deposit will be refunded to offset against the account when the scholar leaves the school, provided that a full term of notice is given.

Textbooks and Stationery:

Stationery packs are provided to scholars from Kingfishers to Grade 7, the cost of which is included in the annual levy.

- Damaged or lost text books will be for the account of the parent.
- Workbook costs up until Grade 7 are included in the annual levy.

Sport and Cultural trips or tours:

Additional charges are levied to cover accommodation and outside transport costs for non-compulsory sports and cultural camps or tours. Parents will be advised of the nature and amount of these charges during the year, depending on their child's selection or involvement in such tours. The amount will be added to the school fee account, but not included in the debit order payment option. This amount should be paid into Penryn's account **in full before the tour departs** via electronic payment. **Please note that the scholar school fee account must be up to date.** For estimated costs, please refer to the summary by school below.

Withdrawal within three weeks (21 days) prior to the tour will not be accepted as tour costs and payments are made well ahead of the time.

Parents are reminded that Penryn accepts no responsibility for the safety of scholars who are on Penryn property after the end of the school day or after official school activities. The Preparatory school will publish the times of all activities and the times they close/end.

- The service closes promptly at 17h00. There will be a charge levied of **R100 per 15 minutes** or part thereof of a child being cared for if parents are late in collecting their child.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS:**PLEASE TAKE NOTE OF THE FOLLOWING TERMS:**

- Fees are payable either termly or monthly, before service begins.
- Indemnity form to be completed and sent to debtors@penryn.co.za
- No refunds will be issued for cancellations or terminations.
- A two-week written notice is required for cancellation, sent to debtors@penryn.co.za.
- The bus schedule must be strictly followed and is monitored by DriveCam.
- Students must be at the drop-off point 10 minutes before pick-up, and parents/guardians must be at the pick-up point 10 minutes before drop-off.
- No special transport arrangements or occasional use of the bus service are allowed.
- For late pick-ups, parents will be contacted via WhatsApp to collect the child at the next drop-off.
- Penryn has a three-strike policy for late pick-ups or drop-offs; after three strikes, the bus service will be terminated.
- Severe lateness incurs a penalty of R250 per hour, payable within 48 hours, with the child supervised at a Penryn hostel.
- Daily communications with drivers can be made via WhatsApp or phone calls between 07:30 am and 5:15 pm.
- Students must follow the School Code of Conduct and respect bus staff and drivers, remain seated and buckled, stow belongings properly, avoid disruptive behavior, and maintain respectful interactions.
- Disciplinary issues will be handled by the School Heads.

Hereby:

1. Request and expressly authorise that my child make use of the bus service offered by Penryn NPC for the remainder of this year, starting on _____, and request that my school account be debited accordingly each term. I undertake to pay the bus fees as per the fee structure, termly or monthly in advance. I undertake to give a full term's notice should I wish to cancel this service.
2. Fully understand the use of the transport is at the parents' own risk.
3. Waive any claim which may arise on my part, or on the part of my child, howsoever arising, against Penryn NPC, its employees or associated parties. I expressly indemnify Penryn NPC and its related parties against any such potential claim or liability.
4. Acknowledge that Penryn NPC may elect to outsource the provision of transport services to a reputable third party transport provider, as and when the need may arise. Any such third-party provider shall be considered an 'associated party' indemnified in terms of this agreement.
5. Agree that my child will be expected to uphold the Penryn code of conduct for scholars while using the services and that failure to uphold this may result in the school initiating disciplinary action in terms of the school's disciplinary code. The children will be under the supervision of a staff member of Penryn NPC, or its appointed agent. Should my child behave inappropriately, the following action will be taken, in addition to any school-based sanctions:
 - i) Misdemeanour 1: a verbal warning will be given from the appropriate Head of School.
 - ii) Misdemeanour 2: a written warning will be given from the appropriate Head of School which must be signed by the parent/guardian and returned to the school.
 - iii) Misdemeanour 3: the scholar will be removed from the bus for the remainder of the term and the following term. Fees will not be refunded for the remainder of that term.
6. Accept that all reasonable precautions will be taken to ensure the safety and wellbeing of my child and that I shall be held responsible for payment of medical and/or hospital expenses, where applicable, should an injury be sustained during the course of the transportation, regardless of the cause thereof.
7. Cede my powers as parent/guardian to the headmaster of the school or his representative should urgent medical treatment be deemed necessary for my child in my absence, and where I cannot be contacted.
8. Understand that, besides in emergency cases described above, the staff of Penryn NPC are not legally permitted to administer medication to my child. Should my child fall ill during the course of the transportation, the driver may contact me and request permission to take my child to the doctor.

- Workbooks for Grade 8 & 9, excluding Afrikaans, French, Siswati and which is subject dependent.
- Included in the annual levy for all **Gr11**, a Matric Dance levy is added.
- *IEB Exam Fees (as explained below) billed in January only for all **Gr10, Gr11 & Gr12** scholars.*

The following conditions apply to the entrance fee:

- Please note that this fee is not related to the tuition fees of Penryn and is allocated solely to the capital development or maintenance of Penryn.
- The entrance fees are non-refundable.
- All scholars entering the College pay the full entrance fee. However, scholars entering the College from Penryn Prep school will only pay a top-up fee to their existing Prep entrance fee.

The following conditions will apply to foreign based parents on application and before entrance into Penryn namely:

- A **non-refundable** entrance fee according to the above fees table must be paid following the successful application of the scholar to enter Penryn.
- In addition, foreign-based parents will be required to pay the following **refundable** deposits, which will be topped up annually to keep up with the increase in fees - payable by 1 January each year, namely:
 - Academic - equivalent to 1 (one) terms fees.
 - Boarding - equivalent to 1 (one) terms fees.
- The refundable foreign deposit will be refunded to offset against the account when the scholar leaves the school, typically in the last term of the scholars Grade 12 year, provided sufficient notice is given.

Printing and Copies:

All scholars from Grade 8-12 are issued a printing and copying username and password. This will enable scholars to make prints and/or copies at school for a nominal cost. Funds can be deposited into the scholar's print account via Multipay at <http://penryn.intelipay.co.za> using the scholar's unique username issued to them.

Lockers:

Gr 8 – 9 scholars will be billed R100 per year for a locker, as this will be compulsory. We encourage each scholar to bring his or her own lock. We suggest a combination lock for this purpose.

Sundry Fees:

Administration fee: - An application fee of **R500** is payable on receipt of an online application.

Re-registration fee: – (due to non-payment of accounts in accordance with our terms and conditions) Should accounts not be settled in full before the end of the year a re-registration fee of **R1000** will be levied. Please be aware that the school's notice period as stated above must still be met and failure to provide adequate notice will result in a term's fees being charged to your account.

Sundry Boarding fees:

- Please refer to the fee structure for termly and weekly boarding options. Should the **weekly** boarding option be chosen an additional nominal cost of R295 per day or R590 per weekend will be charged for scholars staying in the boarding houses over weekends.
- Should scholars make use of the outsourced laundry service, it will be charged at approximately R50 per kilogram.

Textbooks and Stationery:

Scholars from Grade 8 onwards are required to purchase their own stationery in accordance with the lists distributed each year.

- Damaged or lost text books will be for the account of the parent.
- Workbook costs from Grade 8 onwards will be charged separately as this is subject dependent.

IEB (Independent Examination Board) Examination fees:

Fees are set by the IEB and are revised annually. The 2026 matric exam fee is **R9 760** per scholar. To make this cost less onerous on our families, this amount will be split and charged per year over a three-year period. Grades 10, 11 and 12 accounts will be debited each January.

Please note: Penryn will not refund the above fees should a scholar leave after being registered for the IEB NSC exams.

IEB Academic accommodations:

Please note that all scholars who apply for, or receive any academic accommodations do so at their own cost.

The fees for Grade 11 IEBT (Mathematic and Physical Sciences). IEB Grade 12 AP English and/or Mathematics, and IEB Grade 12 Maths/Maths lit program, will be debited to the school fee account.

Sport and Cultural trips or tours:

Additional charges are levied to cover accommodation and outside transport costs for non-compulsory sports and cultural camps or tours. Parents will be advised of the nature and amount of these charges during the year, depending on their child's selection or involvement in such tours.
