- **Conduct and Attitude**  
Exemplary conduct and an attitude of striving for excellence are minimum expectations for scholarship recipients. Should a scholarship scholar cease to be a role model or should he/she fall short of the code of conduct, the scholarship will be withdrawn with immediate effect, at the sole discretion of Penryn.
- **Cancellation of Scholarship**  
Should the scholarship recipient leave Penryn before the five years of High School have been completed, for any reason not mutually agreed upon, the parent/guardian will be liable to repay Penryn the value of the scholarship for the time that the scholar was at Penryn.
